



2021 ROAD CLOSURE INFORMATION

The Old Mutual Wealth Double Century takes place on **Saturday 27 November 2021**.

This unique time trial cycling event sees teams starting in Swellendam and racing via Suurbraak, the Tradouw Pass and Op de Tradouw ascent towards Montagu. The route then passes Ashton, Robertson and Bonnievale, returning via the R317 to Swellendam.

To ensure the safety of the public and cyclists, traffic will be controlled on several public roads. The following temporary road closures have been approved by both Swellendam Municipality and Provincial Department of Roads and Public Work for the duration of the event:
